

# Suzaka City regulations for putting out and separating garbage and recyclables

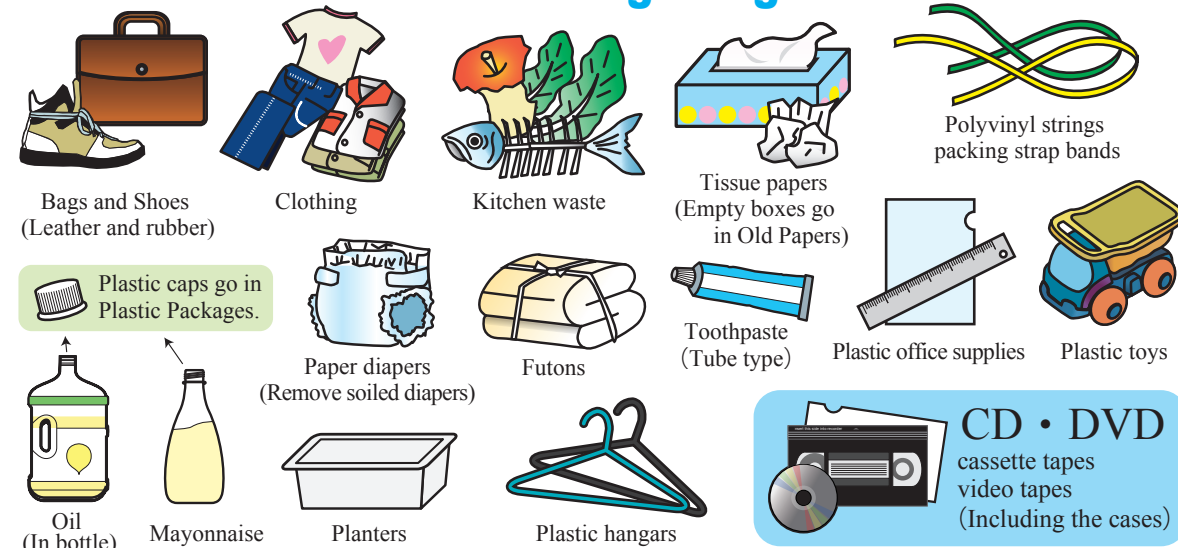
Please put out garbage and recyclables by 8:00am.

Please separate your garbage to help reduce waste.

## Burnable garbage

Collection day : Twice a week

### Suzaka City Designated bag for burnable garbage



- If you put garbage in former designated bags, do affix 30 yen prepaid-stickers to the bags and fill in your name. (See also the below)
- If you put garbage in new designated bags, only fill in your name.
- Be thorough about draining kitchen garbage.
- Please be thorough about sorting garbage to reduce burnable garbage.
- Affix 30 yen prepaid-stickers to the items that cannot put in designated bags such as limbs and comforters.

## Plastic containers and packaging

Collection day : Once per week; pickup days are listed on the "Non-burnable garbage and recyclables" calendar.

### Suzaka City Designated bag for plastic containers and packaging



- Only Plastic Packages can be collected.
- Dispose of plastic products without the marks as Burnable Garbage.
- In case of plastic products with leftovers, do rinse them the inside before disposal.
- Cashier bags are important recyclable garbage. Put them in the designated bags as they.

## Non-burnable garbage

Collection day : Once per month; pickup days are listed on the "Non-burnable garbage and recyclables" calendar.

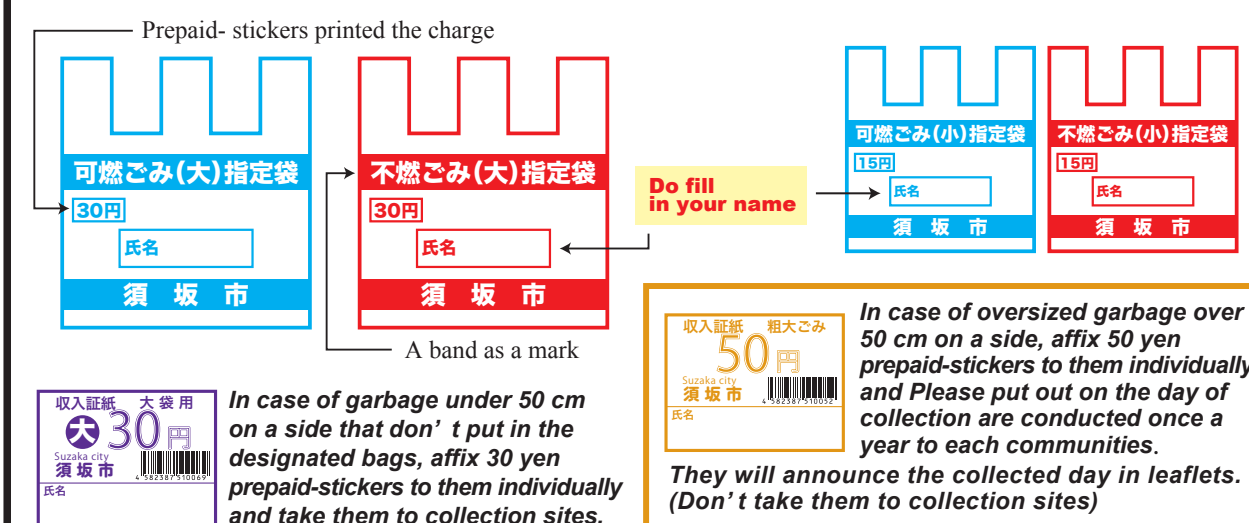
### Suzaka City Designated bag for non-burnable garbage



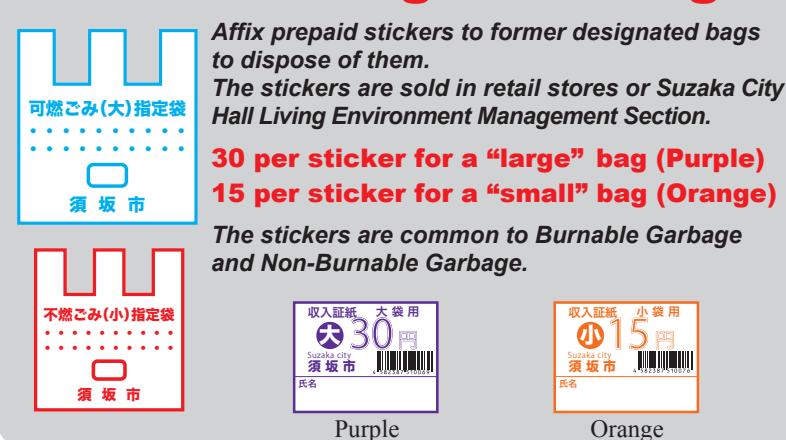
- Affix 30 yen prepaid-stickers to electric appliances under 50cm×50cm×50cm that cannot put in the designated bags.
- Rinse cans of beverage etc. slightly and dispose of them on the scheduled Cans day.
- Do remove batteries from video game machines or noise makers etc.
- It's acceptable to dispose of small electric appliances as Non-Burnable Garbage.

Collection day	Once per month; consult the "Non-burnable garbage and recyclables" pickup day calendar ( You can bring cans, PET bottles, old papers, bottles, dry cell batteries and fluorescent tubes ) into Eco Support Suzaka. ( At 9:30am ~ 11:30am on Saturdays and Sundays )

Rules for separation and putting out	<p>Clear Brown Other colors</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take off the caps and plugs and rinse them before disposal.</li> <li>• Sort bottles into three color categories.</li> <li>• Take off everything but labels and rinse them slightly before disposal.</li> <li>• Return 1.8-L sake bottles and beer bottles to the liquor stores or take them to Group Resource Collection by communities.</li> </ul>	<p>Aluminum Steel</p> <p>須坂市資源物回収箱 カン</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be careful of removing gas from various spray cans.</li> <li>• Do punch a hole out of cans and put them in the designated Non-Burnable Garbage bags.</li> <li>• Rinse the inside of cans. Place cans without sorting them into aluminum or steel in the collection containers.</li> <li>• Rinse cans of fish or pet food. In case of not removing dirt, dispose of them as Non-Burnable Garbage.</li> <li>• Crush aluminum cans if possible in disposal.</li> </ul>	<p>PET</p> <p>Items with this mark are only acceptable.</p> <p>須坂市資源物回収箱 廃食用油</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pour waste botanical edible oil into 1-2-L PET bottles and put caps on the bottles tightly in disposal.</li> <li>• (In case of the oil turned dark brown for oxidation, harden them by chemicals or soak them into newspapers etc. in disposal as Burnable Garbage)</li> <li>• Take off caps and plastic labels from PET bottles and place them in collection nets.</li> <li>• He caps and labels being had taken off go in Plastic Packages.</li> </ul>	<p>須坂市資源物回収箱 廃食用油</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pour waste botanical edible oil into 1-2-L PET bottles and put caps on the bottles tightly in disposal.</li> <li>• (In case of the oil turned dark brown for oxidation, harden them by chemicals or soak them into newspapers etc. in disposal as Burnable Garbage)</li> </ul>	<p>① Newspaper ② Cardboard boxes (Cardboards with inner corrugated liners) ③ Magazines, advertisements, recyclable paper, other paper (Tie them with strings) ④ Milk cartons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sort them into ①~④.</li> <li>• Use paper strings for tying them.</li> <li>• It's acceptable to use paper bags only in disposing of magazines, used tissue papers and other papers.</li> <li>• Place various sorts at collection sites.</li> </ul>	<p>Batteries Used cigarette lighters</p> <p>Thermometers Mercury Thermometers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Put dry cell batteries, clinical thermometers including mercury, thermometers and disposal lighters in nylon bags but the designated bags individually and dispose of them once a month on the scheduled Non-Burnable Garbage day. (Don't have to buy prepaid-stickers)</li> <li>• You can bring cans, PET bottles, old papers, bottles, dry cell batteries and fluorescent tubes into Eco Support Suzaka. (At 9:30am ~ 11:30am on Saturdays and Sundays)</li> </ul>	<p>Straight fluorescent tubes Circle fluorescent tubes Fluorescent bulbs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Don't take fluorescent tubes to collection sites. Dispose of them on the scheduled Oversized Garbage day or bring into Eco Support Suzaka.</li> <li>• It's acceptable to dispose of fluorescent bulbs.</li> <li>• Light bulbs · Glow lamps go in Non-burnable.</li> </ul>

- Televisions (Liquid crystal TV · Plasma TV · Cathode ray tube TV) · Air conditioners · Refrigerator · Freezers · Laundry dryer · Washing machines · Recycling of electric appliances · · ·
- PCs for home use
- Mopeds or scooters · Other motorbike
- Circle fluorescent tubes for home use
- Ni-cad batteries (Rechargeable batteries) · button batteries · coin batteries
- Farming items such as agricultural plastic sheets, chemicals materials and tools etc.
